1 semester of academic mobility abroad in a partner institution



1 internship, in France or abroad, in a partner company or not



Participation in the **QTEM Data Challenge**, a remote group project provided by a partner company (international team of 3 QTEM students), combined with **two e-learning modules** ([more info](#))




50% of ECTS credits in "quantitative" courses during the two years of the Master's programme, including 22 ECTS credits during the mobility semester

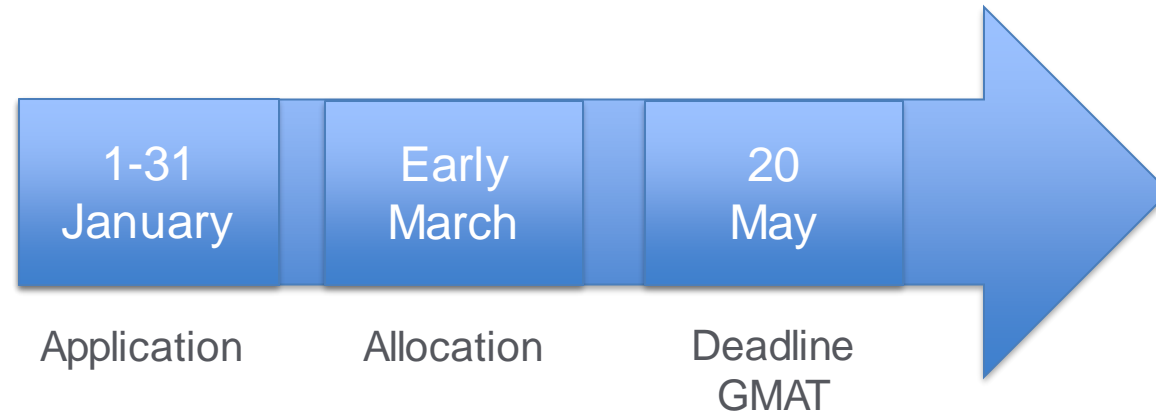

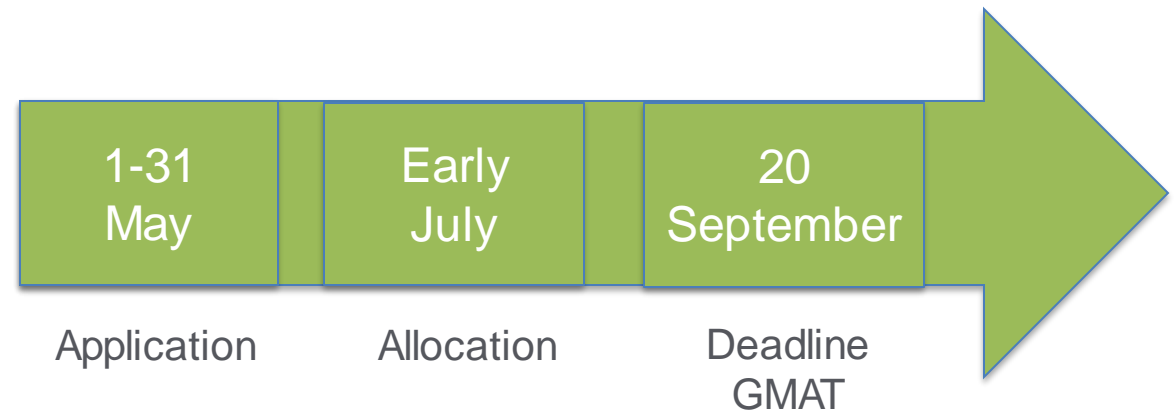
